- 3. Requires a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- 4. Must reside in the First Citizens market area.
- 5. Preference will be given to students who are customers or have family members as customers.

You may attach additional sheets to application if needed. School Guidance Counselor or Principal must sign application. The scholarship recipient will be invited to the First Citizens' Annual Agricultural Forum and given an opportunity to say a few words.
