



First Citizens Community Bank Agricultural Scholarship

Application Deadline: March 15th

First Citizens will award a \$1,000 scholarship annually to a student who will, after high school graduation, continue his or her education in an agricultural related field.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS –

1. Available to a senior high school student.
2. Scholarship will be paid out to the recipient for their second year in college or trade school, upon receipt of the recipient’s prior year transcript.
3. Requires a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
4. Must reside in the First Citizens market area.
5. Preference will be given to students who are customers or have family members as customers.
