

FIRST CITIZENS COMMUNITY BANK BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Annual Application Deadline: June 15

Each year, First Citizens Community Bank will award a one-time \$2,500 scholarship (\$1,250 per semester) to a college student with financial need at the beginning of each semester of their sophomore year. The funds will be sent directly to the school.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Available to a student or his / her immediate family member(s), who must have been a customer for a minimum of two years at the time of application
- Applicant must be an incoming freshman college student enrolled in a four year degree program
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 after completing their freshman year of college
- Minimum of 36 hours of community service each semester
- Applicant must reside in the First Citizens market area
- Full and part-time students are encouraged to apply, with preference given to full-time students.
