They carry out accredited courses, skills training, seminars and workshops, as well as, career and financial counseling. Similarly, the Tioga County Foundation serves to recruit, train, encourage and develop caring individuals to participate in community leadership activities throughout Tioga County.

"We view education as one of our core responsibilities, and are delighted to help through support of these organizations," stated Black.

In the past five years, First Citizens has donated over \$1.2 million dollars to organizations whose goal is to improve the lives of our neighbors.
