First Citizens Opens New Branch in Weaver's Store, Fivepointville

MANSFIELD, PA (October 2018) If you happen to shop at Weavers Store in Fivepointville and have been wondering what all of the construction is about, here's your answer. By year-end, First Citizens Community Bank will open the doors to their newest full-service branch, located in the entrance to Weaver's Store.

The Fivepointville office will be the Bank's second full-service Lancaster County Branch; their Mount Joy branch opened in September of 2016. In 2017, the Bank opened a temporary Loan Production Office in Narvon, Lancaster County, to serve agricultural and business customers. First Citizens knew the Narvon office was temporary; a full-service branch was needed to appropriately serve customers in the eastern county market. The new Fivepointville branch will offer consumer and business deposit and loan products, cash management services, courier services, and a 24-hour drive-up ATM.

He and his customers have been eagerly awaiting a full-service branch. The Narvon Office will close on December 7, 2018 and the Narvon Office staff, along with their customers, will relocate to the new branch.

He is the treasurer of the Pennsylvania Suffolk Sheep Association and Chairman of the Ephrata Sheep Committee. "Since the opening of our Loan Production Office in Narvon, we've been searching for the right location to open a full-service branch," commented Doug Byers, First Citizens Market Executive.
